**Investment Highlights**

One of the most advanced Direct Lithium Extraction (DLE) projects globally

- ▶ **Large 4,600,000 tonne LCE, high-quality North American Brine Resource<sup>(1)</sup>**
  - Prairie Lithium Project – 4.6MT of LCE at 98 mg/L Li (Indicated).
- ▶ **Readily available infrastructure and permitted for production<sup>(1)</sup>**
  - Phase 1 production approval from the Ministry of Energy and Resources in Saskatchewan.
  - The first lithium brine project in Saskatchewan to reach this level of production approval.
- ▶ **Commercial Operations are conditionally approved under the Critical Mineral Processing Investment Incentive.**
- ▶ **The Prairie Lithium project will utilize leading DLE Technology<sup>(2)</sup>**
  - The first commercial scale DLE unit is currently being fabricated.
- ▶ **Proven production of battery grade lithium products<sup>(3)</sup>**

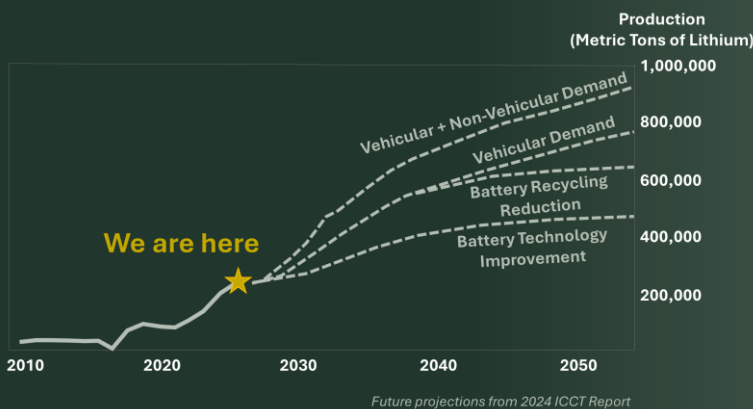
Saskatchewan Ranked No.1 jurisdiction for mining investment in Canada<sup>(5)</sup>

- \$3.08 billion in grants and contributions available for critical minerals projects.

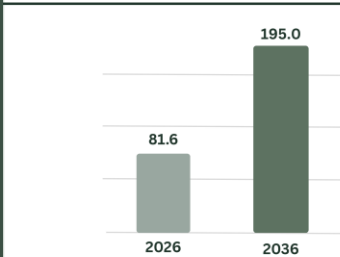
